

## Parents Code of Conduct

This policy was first introduced in 2013. It was devised by staff, Board of Management and the Parents Association.

The aim of this policy is to ensure a safe and respectful environment for all children and adults in our school environment, so that we can continue to flourish, progress and achieve in an atmosphere of mutual understanding.

Parents are expected to:

- Ensure their children attend school and are punctual
- Equip pupils with appropriate school materials, a sufficient healthy lunch and full uniform
- Be courteous and respectful towards pupils and staff at all times
- Make an appointment to meet with a teacher/the Principal through the office
- Respect school property and encourage their children to do the same
- Label pupils coats and other personal property
- Strictly supervise pre-school children, when in the school. Pre-school children are not allowed play on school grounds during school hours or at collection times.
- Not approach staff outside of school hours in relation to school matters
- Respect decisions made by school staff in relation to the selection of school teams/committees or representatives at school events.

As the Board of Management is responsible for the Health & Safety of all staff and students, parents are requested not to approach or reprimand another person's child on the school premises.

- Be responsible for their children prior to the school bell going at 8.50am each morning.
- Be on time to collect their children when school finishes.
